

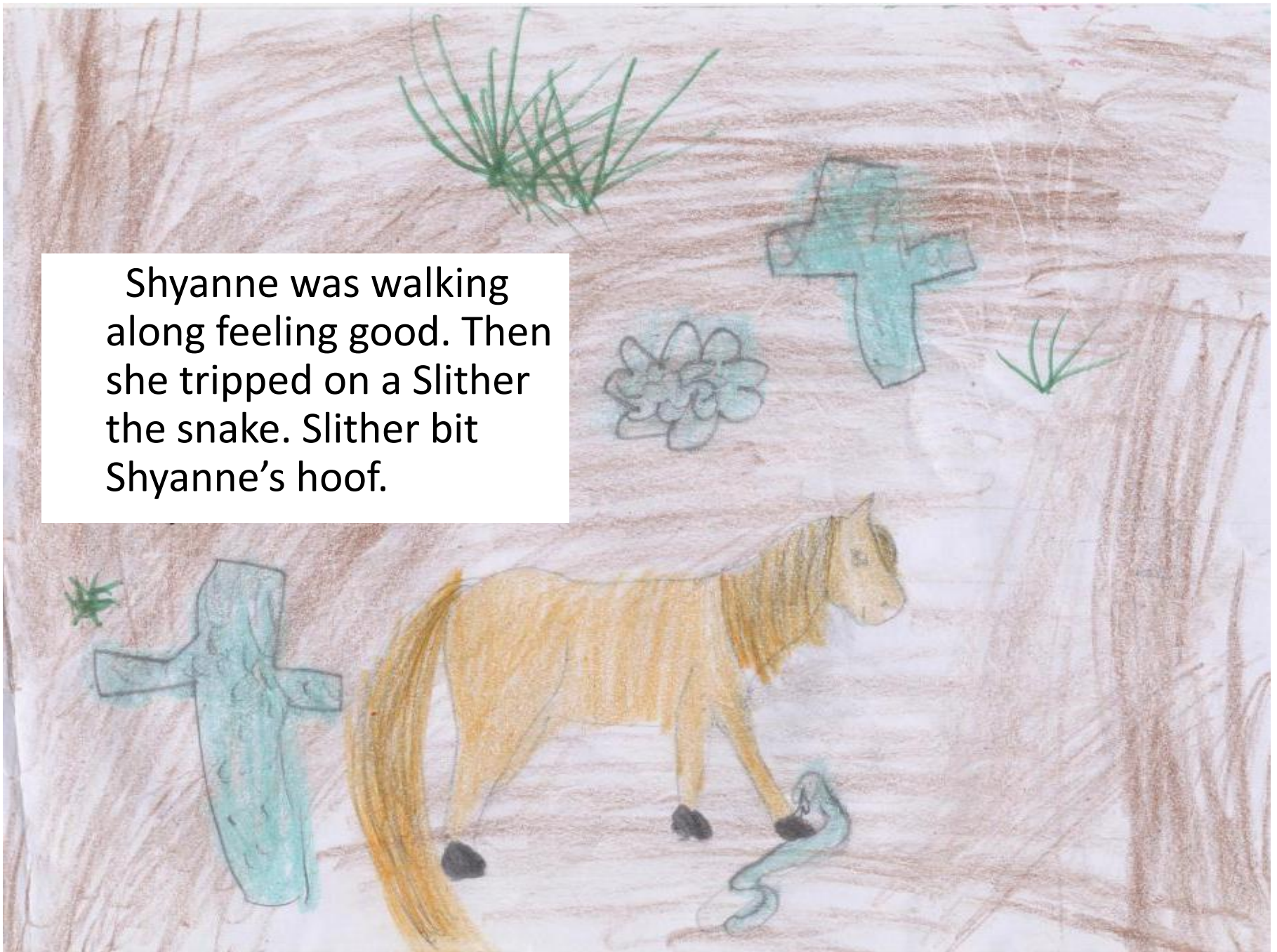

Shyanne was walking along feeling good. Then she tripped on a Slither the snake. Slither bit Shyanne's hoof.







Shyanne bucked and ran at the same time. She bucked for a half an hour.
