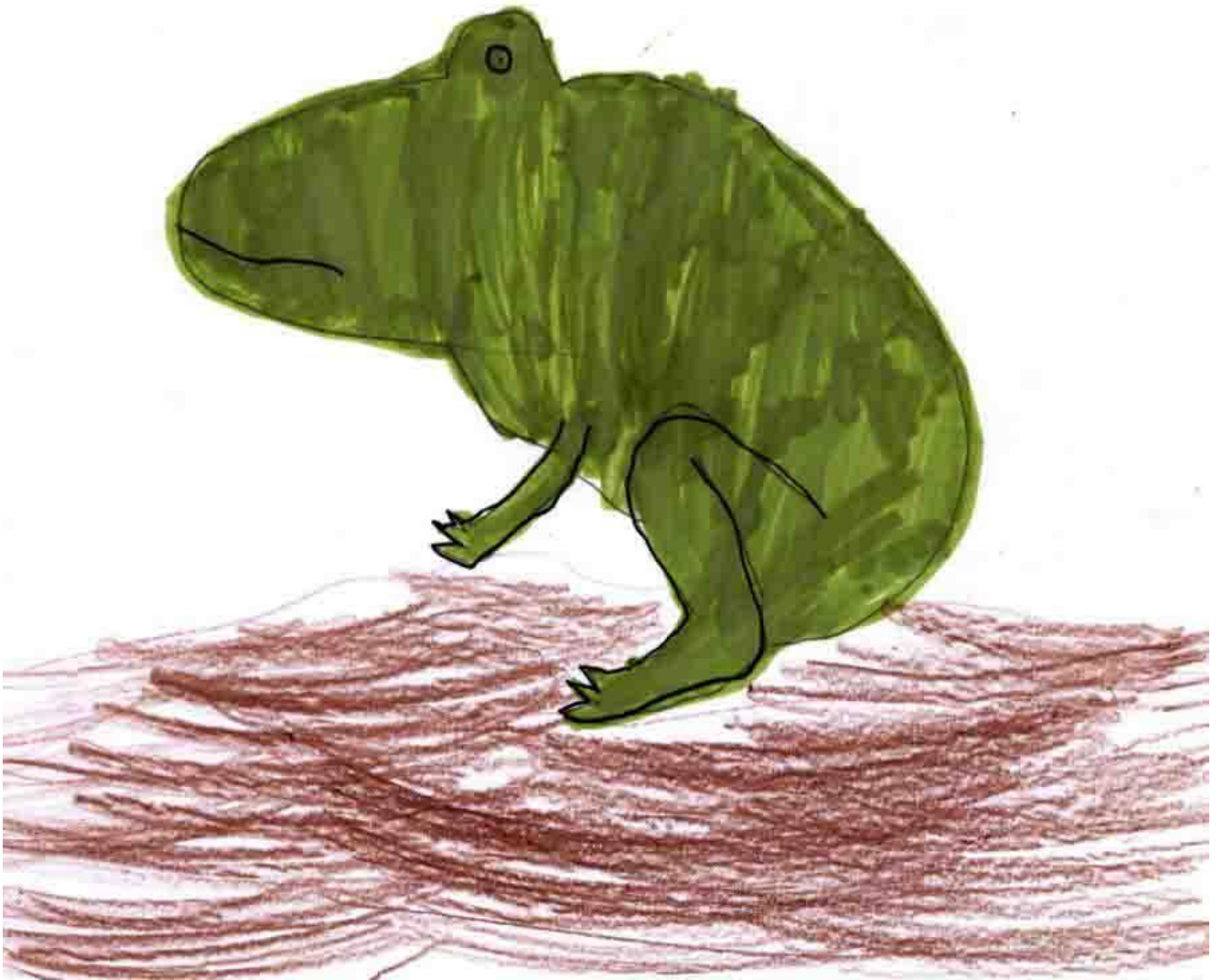
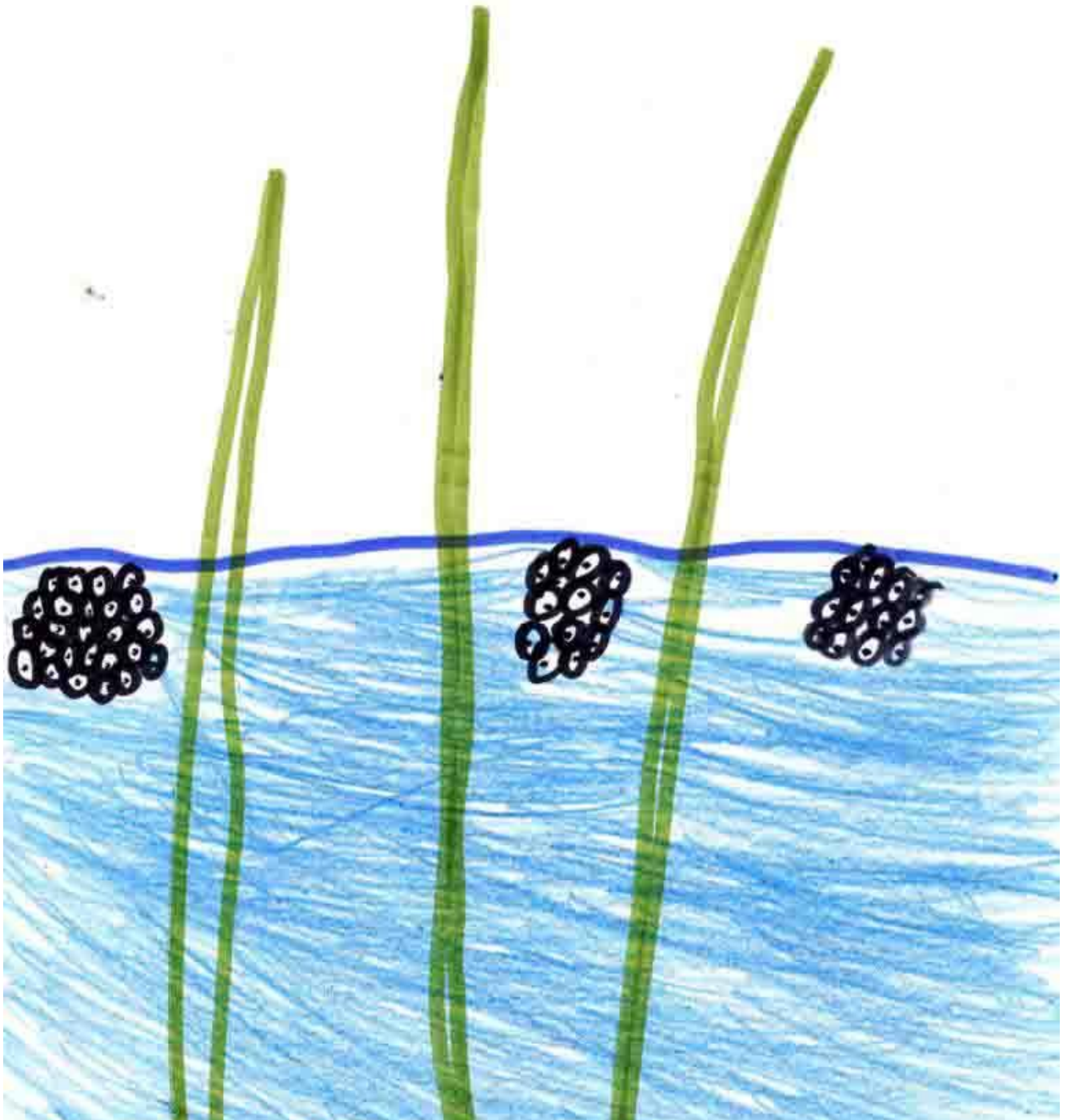


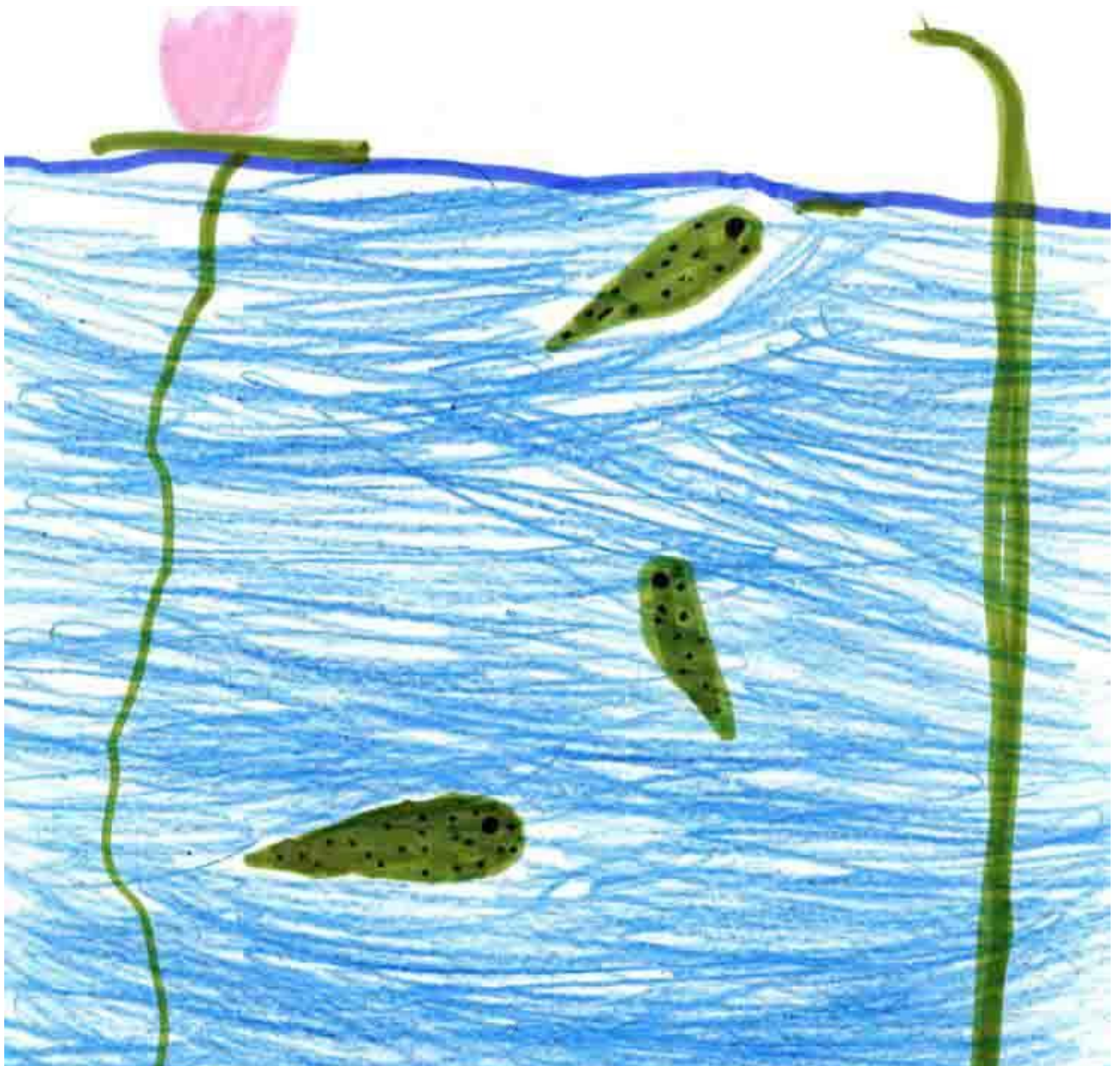
Frog



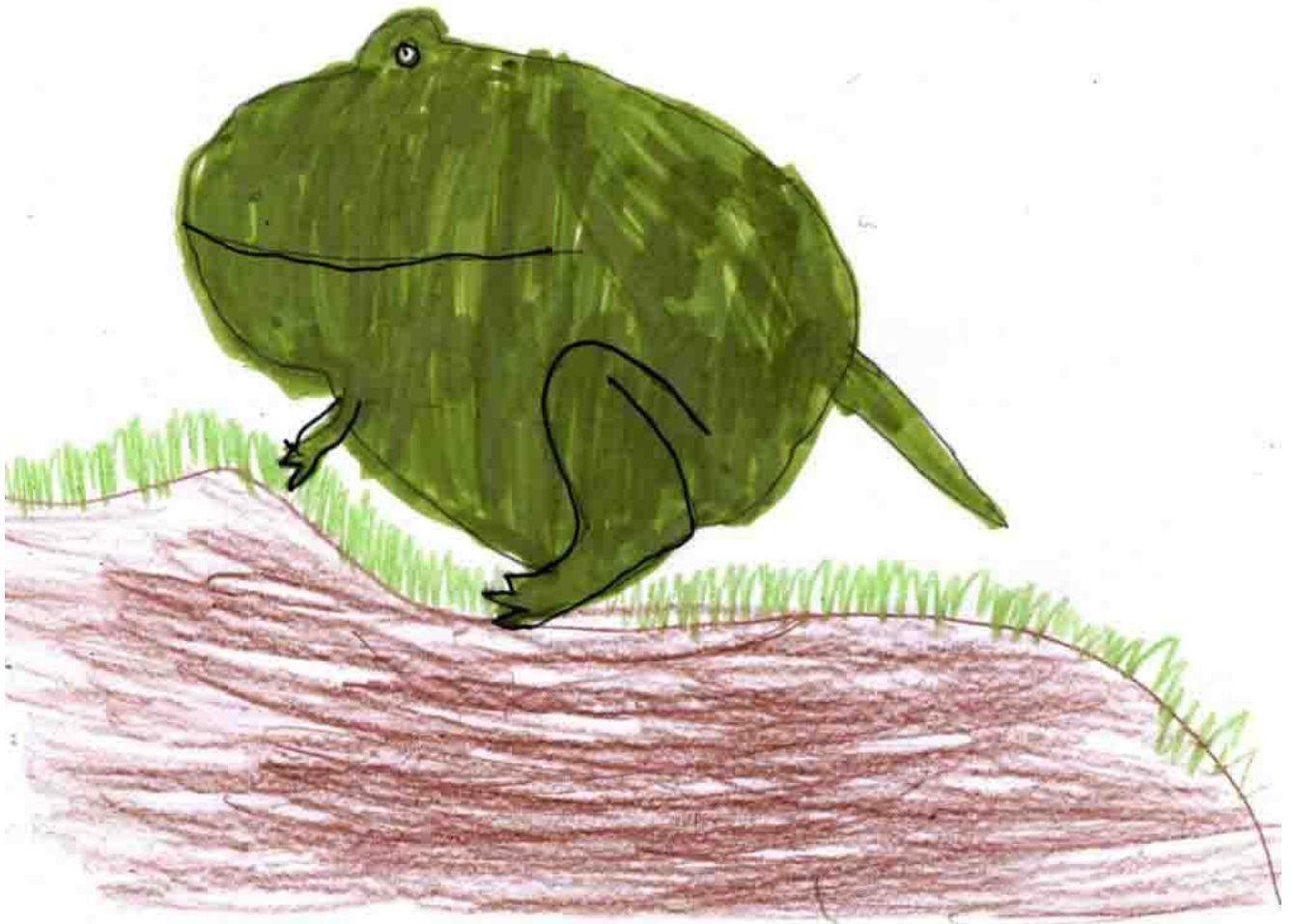
