
Why Cheaters Never Win

They both met each other at the carnival at the games arena.


Then the fox asked, "You want to play ring toss?"


"Sure," said owl. "Before we play, do you want to get some cotton candy and nachos?"

"Sure. Let's get extra cheese on the nachos," said Fox.


"Let's get the mega nachos too," added Owl.

"There now I can concentrate much better," said Fox.




So when the fox came back, fox was throwing his third ring. He got the ring on the bottle!

Owl was so nervous that he was going to lose again that he said, "I need to go to the bathroom."


When owl got to the bathroom he noticed some rings. Then he thought who went to the bathroom and was playing ring toss.


"No let's keep our own rings," replied fox.

"Finally I made one" exclaimed owl.




Fox looked at his ring, then owl, then the bottles, then the panda, then the stuffed lion, and then the carnival speakers.
